



Notes from the meeting held on Thursday, November 7, 2013, in the multi-purpose room A-103 at the Selinsgrove Area Middle School.

Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Five alumni association members were in attendance, as well as high school principal, Mrs. Lorinda Krause.

Twenty-two SAHS graduates and three administrative staff members (Mr. Cohrs, Mrs. Krause and Mr. Longwell) attended the October 12 open house at the high school. We identified the persons who appeared in the photos taken at that event, with the intent of getting the photos published in The Daily Item "Scrapbook" section and on our Facebook page. Those photos will accompany an announcement of the next alumni association meeting, to be held on Thursday, January 9, 2014, at the middle school.

Eric indicated that checking account balance stands at \$1,478.36. With seven new membership registrations just received, our membership total stands at about 75 members.

Dennis Wolfe asked us to reiterate the purpose of our organization. The overall focus is to enable SAHS graduates to reconnect with the SAHS school community. The immediate goal for the dues funds which we are receiving is to cover the expenses of our initial events. It is not to establish and fund a foundation. The foundation goal can come later.

Lowell Leitzel suggested that we could perhaps try to organize activities for a group of alumni by decade (1940-49, 1950-59, etc.).

The group then spent about twenty minutes brainstorming possible activities that we could sponsor (We will need more "people-power" to make these events happen!):

- reunions by decade
- a car show
- an all-alumni dance
- a memorabilia show
- alumni association discounts for tickets to school athletic, musical or theater events
- alumni band and/or choir concerts
- an outstanding alumnus/alumna award
- a Frisbee golf tournament
- tours of all of the campus school buildings

Mrs. Krause also suggested that alumni association members be present at the senior breakfast and awards assembly before graduation day in the spring.

The meeting ended at about 7:50 p.m. Next meeting as noted above (Thurs., Jan. 9, 2013).
