



MEETING MINUTES: MONDAY, FEBRUARY 4, 2019

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm in the Resource Classroom next to the High School Media Center.

Five association members attended, as did SAHS Principal Brian Parise.

Minutes: November 15, 2018 minutes were still not available for review and approval. Minutes of the January 7, 2019 minutes were approved as corrected (Street Fair date corrected to 9/21/19).

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Dennis Wolfe was absent. He did submit a report which noted a balance in the checking account \$2,960.79 as of 12/31/18. The balance in the Seals Legacy Fund remains \$1,283.00.

Membership: No new memberships received

Administrative Update:

- a. High School (Mr. Parise):
 1. The wrestling team won the district team championship for the first time in the 70-year history of the program.
 2. The Technology Student Association (TSA) has seven first place finishers at their regional competition (out of eleven events).
 3. FBLA: Forty students attended the state conference.
 4. Musical production ("Beauty and the Beast") rehearsals progress smoothly with an outstanding set in place. Performances will held March 14-16 in the middle school auditorium.
 5. Nine students participated in regional band.
- b. District: Dr. Cohrs was unable to attend. There were no updates.

Old Business:

1. The merger has been completed between the Rudnitsky Foundation and the Alumni Association. The Articles of Amendment and the Commercial Account Agreement have been filed. A tax ID number has been assigned to the Association.
2. We will host the Selinsgrove summer gazebo concert on Tuesday, June 25. The performers will be Gift, Troutman and Gift.
3. The Slow Bike Race in conjunction with the Rotary Club "Mallet Madness on Saturday, June 8.
4. The date of the Selinsgrove Market Street Festival will be Saturday, September 28
5. Golf Tournament: no update
6. The football homecoming game will be on Friday, October 11, at which time we will introduce the 2019 "Distinguished Alumni" recipient(s).
7. The Alumni Banquet date will be Saturday, October 26. Eric suggested an idea for the program for that evening: to invite Jim Campbell and Bo Fasold to put together a program about SAHS sports by decades, using a PowerPoint photo presentation with narration. Those present were receptive to this idea.

New Business:

1. Kim Soper shared a draft of an ad for the Association in the program for the musical production
2. Eric Rowe shared a sample fundraising flyer for athletic field improvements (from 2002 or 2003) as a resource for promoting our fundraising goals.
