



MINUTES: MEETING OF MARCH 4, 2019

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm in the high school Student Activities Room. Seven association members attended, as did SAHS Principal, Mr. Brian Parise.

Minutes of the November 8, 2018 and the February 4, 2019 meetings were approved with corrections.

Treasurer's Report: Dennis Wolfe reported a checking account balance of \$2,960.79 as of January 31. He also reported a Seals Legacy Fund balance of \$2,117.52 as of December 31. The report was accepted.

Membership: Three new members joined in January.

Administrative Updates:

1. High School: Mr. Parise
 - a. The winter sports seasons have ended. Two wrestlers have advanced to the state tournament. Spring sports practices began today.
 - b. TSA and FBLA students have advanced to the state level of competition.
 - c. The FFA chapter will host a speaking competition this week.
 - d. Nine band members advanced to the regional level and one vocalist sang at an international performance at Carnegie Hall.
 - e. Performances of the musical "Beauty and the Beast" are scheduled for March 14-16.
 - f. Scheduling is underway for next year and should be completed by the end of March.
 - g. As of now, 213 seniors are on track to graduate.

Old Business:

1. Alumni Association/Rudnitsky Foundation merger: We are able to use the Rudnitsky Foundation tax exempt ID number.
2. Earned Income Tax Credit: Eric Rowe need to meet with Bob Bressler to discuss application for this status.
3. Slow Bike Race: Don Ulrich and Dennis Wolfe met with the Rotary Club "Mallet Madness" planning committee to coordinate our event with theirs, scheduled for Saturday, June 8. We will need to request the street closing permit and contact the local neighborhood residents. We also need to begin to promote the event.
4. Street Fair: We will have a booth at this event on September 21.
5. Golf Tournament: no updates
6. Alumni Banquet: Eric Rowe did contact Bo Fasold and Jim Campbell about presenting a program about SAHS sports history at the banquet on October 26. They are willing to plan such a program. Kim Soper is drafting a letter to invite donations for the raffle/auction table.
7. Distinguished Alumni Award: Eric Rowe has updated the nomination form.

New Business:

1. Merchandise Sale: The aerial photo of the high school still needs to be scheduled.
2. "Legacy Room": We discussed this idea for having a room in the high school building with display cases for school history memorabilia. One possibility would be the Student Activities Room in which we meet.
3. Updated Website: The site, with changes, went live today.
4. Baseball Banner: The SAHS Baseball Boosters requested that their group be allowed to advertise their solicitation for fence banner sponsorship on the association web-site. Members indicated no interest in pursuing this idea due to confusion that may arise in regards to sports boosters and the alumni association.
5. Gilson Snowboard: This local company has offered to make snowboards with our name and logo on them and to sell them with a certain portion of their proceeds coming back to us. Members indicated no interest in pursuing this idea.
