



## MINUTES: MEETING OF MAY 03, 2018

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM in Room # 3203. Eight association members attended, as did SASD Superintendent Dr. Chad Cohrs. Shawn Felty from Sire Advertising was present to discuss the proposed web-site.

The minutes of the April 12, 2018 meeting were accepted as presented and entered into the record.

Bob Bressler spoke to the group in regards to his daughter Mary Ellen Bingman who has volunteered to become Secretary of the SAHS Alumni Association. A motion to approve Mary Ellen Bingaman was made by Terry Heintzelman and seconded by Steve Varias. The vote was unanimous in favor of approving Mary Ellen Bingaman as Secretary. Mary Ellen was unable to attend the May meeting but will be present for June, 7.

Treasurer's Report: Dennis Wolfe did not present a report due to the meeting being held prior to the release of the bank statements. Dennis also reported the Street Fair (4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in September) fee has been paid.

Membership: No new members were reported.

### Administrative Updates:

- a. District Superintendent Chad Cohrs: Musical the Wizard of Oz was a huge success and the District is considering moving the event to the Middle School next year; Annual Awards Ceremony is to be held Wednesday, May 30 with graduation to follow that evening in the Garrett Field House at SU; New Assistant Superintendent Dr. Frank Jankowski will start July and comes to the District from the Muncy area; District is beginning to wind up the school year.

### Unfinished Business:

1. E-Commerce/Website: Shawn Felty was present to update the group on the progress of the web-site. The goal is to demonstrate the final version at the next meeting and receive feedback from the group with the intent to go on-line as soon as possible after the meeting.
2. Meeting – Consultant regarding Non-Profit Status: Bob Bressler was in contact with Mr. Rudnitsky to continue options in regards for the 501c3 status of the Association. Bob will work to find a suitable date in order to finalize what needs to occur.
3. Meeting – Slow Bike Race/Selinsgrove Rotary – Different responsibilities were discussed among the members. Dennis will arrange demonstrations with the Middle and High Schools. Eric will contact the newspapers and Sunbury Broadcasting as well as the appropriate Borough organizations to ensure the closure of 10<sup>th</sup> Street occurs correctly. Members of the group agreed to supply other necessary supplies and materials as needed. Members Kim Rowe and Lowell Leitzel agreed to represent the Alumni Association in Mallet Madness. The necessary forms and entry fee will be submitted. Bob reported that at the date of the meeting we have secured at least \$400.00 in sponsorship which will cover our prize money. Plans for the Slow Bike Race will be finalized at the next meeting.
4. Alumni Banquet – Date/Theme: Eric will contact the school in regards to Temporary Use of Grounds in order for the banquet to be held in the cafeteria similar to last year. Kevin Oswald will also be informed of the date and our intent for the same serving arrangements. The group agreed that the one-room school house presentation that Charlie Benner has should be utilized at the banquet.
5. Development Plan "Legacy Fund": Nothing to be done with the development plan until the non-profit status of the Alumni Association is finalized.
