



## MINUTES: MEETING OF MAY 6, 2019

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:35pm in the Student Activities Room of the high school. Seven association members attended, as did SAHS Principal, Mr. Brian Parise.

The minutes of the April 1, 2019, meeting were approved as presented.

**Treasurer's Report:** As of March 31, checking account balance stood at \$2,187.36. The Seals Legacy Fund balance continues to hold at \$2,117.52. The report was accepted.

**Membership Update:** One new member joined in March.

**Election of Officers and Directors:** Kim Soper motioned, seconded by Kim Rowe, we postpone election of officers and directors until our June meeting, due to poor attendance at this meeting. The motion was passed.

**Meeting Date and Time:** Kim Rowe made a motion, seconded by Chris Pirie, that we hold our monthly association meetings on the first **Monday of each month (pending Monday holidays) at 11:00 AM**, in a room designated by the high school principal. The motion was passed.

**Administrative Update:** Principal Parise reported that the school year is winding down quickly. The Senior Awards Assembly will take place at 9:00 AM on May 28, with commencement to be held that same day at 7:00 PM in the fieldhouse at Susquehanna University. That last day of classes will be May 31. The prom, held at the Susquehanna Valley Country Club, was a success, with over 330 students in attendance. Bids have been accepted for Phase 2 construction at the high school, which will include renovations and additions to the kitchen, upgrading of the locker rooms, relocation of the tennis courts and providing additional parking. Principal Parise hopes to prepare a newsletter and/or a press release in order to publicize the many successes of SAHS students during this school year.

### Old Business:

1. Rudnitsky Foundation/Alumni Association merger: Eric Rowe and the Rudnitsky Foundation has signed and submitted a letter to the IRS for filing to and include the correct EIN.
2. Senior Awards Assembly: Eric Rowe will attend and share comments and congratulations from our association.
3. June 25 Gazebo Concert: Eric will order two sheet cakes from Heimbach's. Other members will provide beverages and other items.
4. June 8 Slow Bike Race: We will need help to set up. Eric has a copy of last year's letter to solicit sponsors. Eric and Dennis will publicize the event in a radio interview on May 30. There is a \$5.00 entry fee. Kim Soper has obtained gift cards to offer as prizes for category winners. The Selinsgrove Rotary Club's "Mallet Madness" will take place that day. Lowell Leitzel is willing to play on behalf of the association, but needs a partner.
5. Market Street Festival: September 28. We have paid to reserve a space for our stand.
6. October 26 Alumni Banquet: Eric met with Bo Fasold and Jim Campbell to plan the program: SAHS sports by the decade. Jim Campbell will provide a recorded narration. We would like to ask high school tech students to help prepare the photos and/or videos.
7. Distinguished Alumni Award: Eric shared a completed nomination form that he received.
8. Golf Tournament: It will not take place.
9. Merchandise Sales: no update on the photos of the high school
10. Legacy Room: drawings have not yet been received
11. Recruitment of Active Committee: We need more members to become involved in various committees in order to plan future activities and events.
