



## MINUTES OF MEETING ON AUGUST 10, 2017

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order in the high school main office conference room at 4:05 pm.

Six association members attended, as did SAHS Principal Brian Parise.

Minutes of the July 18 meeting were approved as written.

Treasurer Dennis Wolfe reported a balance in the checking account of \$1,197.90 as of July 31, and a balance of \$5,769.16 in the Seals Legacy Fund. He also reported that we had added three new members in July, and he urged us to recruit younger members.

Correspondence: We received a letter from the SAHS lacrosse program, thanking us for our recent donation.

### Discussion/Action Items:

1. School update: Principal Parise reported that fall sports programs are beginning practices. He indicated that freshman orientation will take place during the evening of August 16. He also shared information about the newly adopted board of education policy related to the code of conduct for non-curricular activity and athletics participants, as it relates to random drug testing. There is also a new school store across from the main office.
2. Superintendent Cohrs had given to Dennis Wolfe a proposal for a message board for in front of the high school, at the approximate cost of \$20,000. Charlie Benner made a motion, seconded by Dennis Wolfe, that we promote as a Legacy Fund goal our support for funding indoor, and possible outdoor, messaging boards for the high school. The motion was passed.
3. Slow Bike Race at the Market Street Festival: Dennis plans to discuss this possibility with a representative of Selinsgrove Projects, Inc., which organizes the street festival activities. We will have our regular promo stand at the same location as last year for the festival.
4. 2017 Distinguished Alumni awards: Eric is working on ordering the plaques for Jim Campbell and Dave Bowersox. He needs to get biographical information about both gentlemen. The presentation of the awards will take place at the homecoming football game on Sept. 29.
5. Alumni banquet: Eric distributed tickets to the members present, as well as promotional flyers. The banquet will begin at 6:00 pm, with the doors opened at 5:00 pm. One of the high school choral ensembles will perform. Don Ulrich has made a frame for the "High School Sweethearts" photos. Eric will do a radio interview on Sept. 7 to promote the banquet. Don Ulrich suggested asking radio station WHMA 92.3 to do some promo for us as well.
