



MEETING MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 7, 2021

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 11:02 am in the Student Activities Room at the high school. Seven association members attended, as did SASD Superintendent Dr. Frank Jankowski and SAHS Principal Mr. Matt Conrad.

Minutes August 2, 2021: Minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report: Report August 2021 – Check Book = \$3297.63, Legacy Fund \$4931.00
Dennis reported there continue to be problems with our PayPal account.

Membership: We have received a couple of new memberships.

Administrative Updates:

1. **High School:** Mr. Conrad reported the school recently held an school Club Expo held in an attempt to expose students to the various clubs offered. The intent of the outreach is an attempt to keep students more connected with the school. The event was well received.
2. **District:** Dr. Jankowski reported the borough approved the school's request for a variance in order to move forward with the installation of the electronic signs. The bids are expected to go out with the intent of approval at the October School Board meeting. We are not sure if 1 or 2 signs will be constructed. Dr. Jankowski updated the group on the current status of the COVID-19 situation at the school. The goal of the school is not to be the "mask police" but for the staff to focus on student learning. Tuesday, September 8 will be first day of the mask mandate for all students except for those qualifying for exemptions.

Association Activities:

1. October 15 Golf Tournament: Eric reported there is approximately \$6,000 collected in sponsorships and players fees. A few teams have signed up but he and Dave continue to work at soliciting donations and teams. Dave and Eric met with SVCC and a bag lunch will be provided for players at the turn. We have received donations from grocery stores in order to provide players with water, snacks, etc. We also need to finalize the extra "games" and fund raising activities for the day. Eric asked that all available committee members be ready to help during the morning registration.
2. October 15 Homecoming Football Game: Plaque presentation will occur prior to presentation of Homecoming Court. Eric will write the brief introductions. Rich Mease and Kendra Aucker will be present.
3. November 6 Alumni Banquet: A group of committee members met with Kevin Oswald to finalize the menu and visited the cafeteria to determine serving order and seating. The group will meet with the Facilities and Grounds Director to set-up the cafeteria for the banquet. Craig Sholley has agreed to do his presentation. Kim Soper asked that items for the Chinese Auction be limited to a maximum of \$25.00.
4. Athletic Hall of Fame: No updates.
5. Street Fair – Set for September 25. Dennis reported that we have not heard back from SPI to date so we don't know where our booth will be set-up. Eric reported the set-up and activities for the day (if it will be held) will follow the same pattern as in previous years and asked for anyone available that day to help at the stand.
6. Seal Sculpture: No updates.
7. Fall Into The Grove – Radio spots are scheduled for the Golf Tournament and Swimming Pool 5K the morning of October 4 at 7:10 AM on WKOK's "On The Mark".
