



MEETING MINUTES OF MAY 6, 2021

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 11:05 AM in Room 109 at the high school. Eight association members attended, as did SAHS Principal, Mr. Matt Conrad, and SASD Superintendent, Dr. Frank Jankowski.

Minutes - April 12, 2021: Approved with one correction: board member nominee was Kim Rowe, not Kim Soper.

Treasurer's Report: Dennis Wolfe reported a checking account balance of \$3,213.76. He reported we received donations of \$200 and of \$500 to the Seals Legacy Fund in memory of Beth Parker, Class of 1987. The report was accepted.

Membership: Dennis Wolfe reported we received two new memberships since April.

Administrative Updates:

1. **High School:** Mr. Conrad reported the prom held May 1 at the intermediate school was successful. He credited much of that success to Tracy Hepner, Jr. Class Advisor, and Taylor Robinson, Sr. Class Advisor. The end-of-year activities are being planned: senior awards assembly, Baccalaureate Service on May 23, and graduation at the athletic stadium on May 28.
2. **District:** Dr. Jankowski reported that all of the usual end-of-year activities are being planned in each school. All efforts are being made for students to have successful conclusions to their course work this year. Governor Wolfe's May 31 lifting of Covid restrictions will not really affect our district. The hope is to open the 2021-22 school year without masks. An online instruction option will be offered. He has received some input from building principals about possible designation of proceeds from our upcoming Alumni Golf Tournament. At the elementary and intermediate schools, those ideas include support for the school-wide positive behavior/culture enhancement initiatives and providing musical instruments for students who do not have them. At the middle school and high school, the ideas include providing picnic tables and benches for the flexible lunch program (outside in good weather) and perhaps a Seals statue/sculpture at the school entrance to enhance school spirit.

Association Activities:

1. Homecoming: The game date is Friday, October 15, and the tentative banquet date is November 6. Eric will contact Justin Simpson about which school cafeteria would be available.
2. Distinguished Alumni Award: The nomination deadline is June 1. Eric has already contacted awardee Craig Sholley who has accepted the recognition. Eric will contact Craig to determine his availability for the football game/banquet activities.
3. Seals Legacy Room: No update yet with the Athletic Hall of Fame group
4. Golf Tournament: The date is October 15. Eric revised the Royal Blue hole sponsor fee to \$200. We will start promoting the event in mid-June.
5. Street Fair: no update
6. "Seal Barker" newsletter: We reviewed Eric's draft with the intent to distribute to members within the next two weeks. We hope to begin adding the names and class years of new members.
