The football boosters organized a drawing to enable some elementary, intermediate and middle school students to have lunch with a football player.
2. **District:** Dr. Jankowski was unable to attend.

Association Activities:

1. **Nov. 4 Performing Arts Celebration:** Nick Park (2005) is willing to do some graphic art work to promote our event. He will be one of nine total performers (6 in person and 3 via an online reel) that evening. A reception will be begin at 5:00 pm, with the program to start at 6:00. Eric will introduce the 2023 Distinguished Alumni Award recipients, and then Jay Mueller will serve as MC for the program. Jay Snyder can attend, with Jennifer Gunn, Nathan Troup and Elizabeth DeShong sharing video recorded acceptances and their performance videos.
2. **Sports Hall of Fame:** Ace of Signs can help hang the plaques on the rear parking entrance lobby wall. The committee will meet again soon.
3. **Oct. 13 Golf Tournament:** Sponsorships have totaled \$6,755 to date, including three \$1,500 cart sponsorships, \$1,000 for food and six hole sponsors at \$200 each. Team registrations are coming in.
