



MEETING MINUTES - APRIL 4, 2022

President Eric Rowe called the meeting at 11:05 am in the Student Activities Room at the high school. Eight association members attended, as did Dr. Matt Conrad, SAHS Principal, and Dr. Frank Jankowski, SASD Superintendent.

Minutes March 7, 2022: Minutes were approved as written, with a few spelling corrections.

Treasurer's Report: No update on the checking account balance. The balance in the Seals Legacy Fund was \$20,012.00, as of the end of February.

Membership: We have received no new memberships since the last meeting.

Administrative Updates:

1. **High School:** Dr. Conrad reported that spring sports are underway, with an invitation track and field meet coming up on a Saturday in April. At that meet, the throwing area will be dedicated in memory of Coach George Hummel. Prom is scheduled for May, 7. Graduation will take place in the stadium at 7:00 pm on Thursday, June 3 (rain date, June 4). The last student day will be on June 4.
2. **District:** Dr. Jankowski reported that the school board approved the installation of one electronic sign at the corner of Broad Street and Seals Avenue, to be completed in June or July. The installation of new field lights at the stadium has also been approved, to be installed this summer as replacements for the current lights, dating back to 1957 after a relocation from Sunbury. After gathering input from building administrators and instructional staff, Dr. Jankowski proposes that the \$10,000 donation from the Seals Legacy Fund (raised from last year's golf tournament) be designated for the following items: (1) to purchase wood for picnic tables at the middle school, to be made by students at the high school; (2) to provide positive behavior prizes for K-5 students; and (3) to help fund an fenced-in addition to the elementary school playground along Seals Avenue.

Golf Proceeds Proposal Action: Terry Heintzeman moved, with a second by Dave Hess, that we approve Dr. Jankowski's proposal (listed above) for the designations of our \$10,000 donation from the Seals Legacy Fund. The motion was PASSED.

Association Activities:

1. **Homecoming:** The game (the 1,000th for Seals football) is scheduled for October 7. The banquet is scheduled for November 5. Eric met with Cristi Beeler, art teacher, concerning our visual arts theme. She is designing a promotional flyer and is drafting information for alumni artists to submit items for display at the banquet.
2. **Distinguished Alumni Award:** The nomination form is on the website. We are promoting nominations through the newsletter, our Facebook page, and the local newspapers.
3. **Sports Hall of Fame:** Dave Hess reported that the membership on the selection committee has been completed.
4. **Golf Tournament:** It will be held on October 7, to benefit the Seals Legacy Fund. We need to consider prizes for the golfers.
5. **Website:** Updates have been made.

New Business:

1. We discussed providing Seals stress relievers and Alumni Association information for the seniors at the conclusion of the graduation ceremony and having a table next to the student packet/diploma table.
