



## MEETING MINUTES: FEBRUARY 7, 2022

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 11:00 AM in the Student Activities Room of the high school. Ten association members attended, as did SAHS Principal Dr. Matthew Conrad.

**Minutes January 3, 2022:** The minutes were approved as presented.

**Treasurer's Report:** Dennis Wolfe reported account balances: Checking Account = \$17,049.75 as of Dec. 31, 2021; Seals Legacy Fund = \$4,931.00 as of June 30, 2021. Dennis announced he would be stepping down as treasurer in March. He reported that Kim Soper is willing to take his place.

**Membership Update:** No additions since our last meeting

### Administrative Updates:

1. **High School:** Dr. Conrad reported on the partnership between the Technology Education Department and Keystone Wood Products Association, through whose grant the department has purchased some new sanders. The Technology Students Association chapter competed recently in the PA Region 7 competition, in which 36 of the 37 SAHS participants qualified for advancement. The Guidance Department staff are currently working with students with course selection for the 2022-23 school year. The goal is for students to receive their schedules for next year before the end of the current school year.
2. **District:** Dr. Jankowski was unable to attend. Dr. Conrad shared that all classrooms in the district are now equipped with Promethean Boards. Dennis Wolfe shared that Dave Hess has succeeded him as president of the SASD Board of Directors.

### Association Activities:

1. **Homecoming:** We will hold our Second Annual SAHS Alumni Association Golf Tournament on Friday, October 7, with the Homecoming football game to be held that evening.
2. **Alumni Banquet:** We have selected Saturday, November 5, as the date for the banquet. We still need to submit the request for the use of the high school kitchen and cafeteria. Eric reported that he, Kim Soper, and Kim Rowe met with SAHS art teacher Cristi Beeler to discuss our theme of promoting the visual arts. We will invite alumni artists to display some of their works at the banquet. Eric shared a written report describing how we will try to make that happen.
3. **Distinguished Alumni Award:** Eric has received one nomination already for 2022. The nomination deadline is June 30.
4. **SAHS Sports Hall of Fame (proposal):** Dave Hess, with the help of Jim Messner and Bill Bechtel, presented a draft of proposed guidelines for the establishment of a SAHS Sports Hall of Fame. Dave also presented a list of potential members for the initial selection committee. After discussion including editorial revisions to the proposed guidelines, Dennis Wolfe made a motion, seconded by Kim Rowe, that we adopt the guidelines for the creation of a SAHS Sports Hall of Fame, with the HOF Selection Committee to be a committee of the SAHS Alumni Association. The motion was PASSED. Dave Hess and his planning group will recruit the initial HOF Selection Committee members, who must be members of the alumni association.

### New Business:

1. Eric Rowe made a motion, seconded by Dave Hess, that we purchase a full-page ad in the program for the upcoming musical "Godspell" at a cost of \$100. The motion was PASSED.
