



Meeting Minutes - September. 6, 2022

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 11:00 AM in the Student Activities Room at the high school. Nine association members attended, as did SAHS Principal, Dr. Matt Conrad, and SASD Superintendent, Dr. Frank Jankowski.

Minutes - August 1, 2022: A motion was made by Charlie Benner, seconded by Dennis Wolfe, to approve the August 1 meeting minutes as presented. The motion PASSED.

Treasurer's Report: Kim Soper reported a checking account balance of \$2,514.14 and a Seals Legacy Fund balance of \$11,085.09. A motion was made by Dave Hess, seconded by Patt, to accept the report. The motion PASSED.

Membership: One new membership was received via the parent letter sent to each senior.

Administrative Updates:

- 1. High School:** Dr. Conrad reported on the beginning of the school year. Fall sports are up and running, Picture Day has already occurred, and preparations are underway for Homecoming. He also noted that, although the overall start to the school year was good, the year also began with a tragedy, with one of the students losing his life. With all the good that happened, this certainly was a tremendous blow to the student body as well as the faculty and staff. He also spoke to the high level of student engagement in sports, clubs, extracurricular, etc.
- 2. District:** Dr. Jankowski remarked about the progress of the project to install some fencing at the Elementary School. He stated the old stadium lights being replaced and the plans for a piece of the old light standards to be displayed with an informational plaque detailing some of its history. He then shared about the upcoming K-12 pep rally on Sept. 23 (weather permitting). Dr. Jankowski also mentioned that although from a large view, the opening of the school year was quite successful, the tragic death of a High School student was one of the worst things that can happen. He too shared his remorse for the situation.

Association Activities:

- 1. Street Fair:** Eric requested help to set up the booth and members help throughout the day..
- 2. Homecoming, October 7:** The award presentation will occur during the pre-game activities.
- 3. Banquet, November 5:** The group to keep ticket prices the same as 2021. Eric expressed concern about the Art Show part of the banquet. People are encouraged to reach out to Alumni artists to encourage their participation.

- 5. Athletic Hall of Fame:** no updates
- 6. Golf Tournament, October 7:** Eric and Dave continue to recruit sponsors/players. Set is at 8:00 and registration at 9:00. Over \$4,000 has been collected to date but still in need of layers and sponsors. Eric will do some PSA's on local radio stations regarding the event.
- 7. Information Flyer:** Sample was misplaced, but will be discussed at future meetings.
