



MEETING MINUTES: OCTOBER 2, 2022

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 11:05 am in the Student Activities Room at the high school. Nine association members attended, as did SAHS Principal Dr. Matt Conrad and SASD Superintendent Dr. Frank Jankowski.

Minutes - September 6, 2022: Meeting were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report: Kim Soper reported the following account balances: Checking \$14,425.14; Seals Legacy Fund \$11,089.10. The report was accepted.

Membership: Dennis Wolfe reported that we have received five new memberships, with a few more forthcoming.

Administrative Updates:

1. **High School:** Dr. Conrad reported on a successful "Literacy under the Lights" event on September 28. This is homecoming week, with daily spirit themes all week. The football game against Central Mountain on Friday evening will be the 1,000th game in SAHS football history. The homecoming court, Distinguished Alumni Award recipients and former football coaches will be recognized before the game. The homecoming dance will be held from 7:00 to 10:00 pm on Saturday.
2. **District:** Dr. Jankowski asked what support is needed from the district for upcoming alumni association events. Eric outlined areas of need for the Oct. 7 golf tournament and the Nov. 5 alumni banquet. On Sunday evening, October 9, the National Honor Society induction ceremony will be held in the high school auditorium.

Association Activities:

1. **Homecoming:** Award recipient John Gallagher will probably be the only one able to be present at the game on Friday. We still need some expanded bio info from him.
2. **Golf Tournament, October 7:** Tee off is at 10:00 am. We need to be present at around 8:30 to begin registration and selling mulligans, memberships and association merchandise. Nineteen teams have registered so far. Golfers will be assigned carts, which will have ads for our meal and cart sponsors. Eric will obtain beverages. The country club will put sandwich labels on the lunch bags. We will offer clubhouse gift certificates as prizes and will provide small favor bags. Dave Hess reported that we have received \$5,375 in golfer fees and about \$2,000 in sponsorships.
3. **Alumni Banquet, November 5:** We are still hoping to get alumni art work for display. We will need a meal count in advance. Mike Bennett will do an original SAHS Seal for presentation at the banquet.
