



MEETING MINUTES - MARCH 10, 2025

President Eric Rowe called the meeting to order at 11:02 am in the Student Activities Room at the high school. Eleven association members attended, as did SAHS Principal Dr. Matt Conrad and SASD Superintendent Dr. Frank Jankowski.

Minutes - February 3: Kim Rowe moved, Sue Herrold second to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was PASSED.

Treasurer's Report: Kim Soper reported a checking account balance of \$9,992.36 and a Seals Legacy Fund balance of \$35,060.48. Lowell Leitzel moved, Shawn Felty second to accept the treasurer's report. The motion was PASSED.

Administrative Updates:

- A. **High School:** Dr. Conrad reported that two boys and two girls qualified for the PIAA State Wrestling Tournament. Karissa Springer became a state medalist, finishing fifth overall. A multi-district career fair was held at Susquehanna University on March 5. SAHS juniors and seniors attended. Six students qualified to perform in the PMEA Regional Band Concert held in Williamsport. Nine forensics students qualified for the PA High School Speech League state competition. The musical production, *Mamma Mia!*, was a great success.
- B. **District:** Dr. Jankowski reported that professional development sessions were held in the first week of March, with the focus on school safety. He has received some school-level proposals for the use of proceeds from the 2024 golf tournament. He asked us to consider making a donation for school safety enhancements, such as blinds to cover the windows in classroom doors.

Association Activities:

- A. **Association Promotional Folder:** Shawn Felty shared a proposed copy of a brochure insert for the folder. The folder will measure 9" by 12", with the insert measuring perhaps 8 1/2" by 11". He needs some photos and staff and student quotations in order to complete the insert design, and then he can provide a price quotation.
- B. **Distinguished Alumni:** The newsletter will go out this week, with an announcement about the June 1 nominations deadline. We also discussed how best to display the names of our Distinguished Alumni in the high school building, perhaps near or beside the proposed SAHS Sports Hall of Fame display.
- C. **Sports Hall of Fame:** The committee is looking at a total of ten inductees this year. Most of them have been selected. The ceremony will take place on May 17.
- D. **Golf Tournament:** The date is Friday, October 10.
- E. **Tax-Exempt Status:** The application has been completed and is ready for submission.
